She is a co-founder of the Richmond Autism Interagency Committee – a group dedicated to increasing opportunities for people with autism to be accepted and celebrated in their communities.

Morning Session – What can lead to challenging behaviours?

All behaviour comes from unmet needs. Sensory regulation, emotional regulation and strong relationships are the foundation for cognitive, communicative and other social skills! The morning session will be an introduction to the need for strong relationships and sensory processing disorders.

Afternoon Session - What is the challenging behaviour telling us and what are some strategies we can use?

In this session we will talk about how to look at behavior as communicating a need and how to figure out that need. We will also learn about strategies that strengthen your relationships, and help children to learn to self-regulate.
